

What is CAGA!


- The voice for students on academic issues at the departmental, Faculty and Senatorial levels of Carleton University

- Funded by a levy from students for scholarships, academic initiative funding, study snacks and more!



- Councillor Training Sessions (and other workshops TBD)


- Being a department representative also means

Proxy, Absences and

- If you cannot attend a council meeting, it is required to send me an email notifying me of your absence.
- This email must also include the name and email of your proxy- this must be somebody from your program.
- Failure to do this 2 times, will result in a meeting to discuss your responsibilities as a councillor
- Failure to do this 3 times, will result in no credit being earned on your CCR





- Order of Motions

ERNANCE 101

- Amendments to Motions
- Friendly amendments can be accepted by the Mover without a vote Ο Other amendments are moved by a council member and require a seconder Ο Chair opens the amendment to Questions and Debate Ο

- Amendment must be voted on before returning to the original motion Ο
 - Point of Order
- Allows a council member to raise concern to the Chair if a rule has been broken
- Council can overturn decisions by the chair with a simple majority Ο

- Call to Question
- Moves the Motion directly to a vote, cutting off debate
 - Final approval or rejection of the motion
